<p align="center">INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER:</p> <p>1. To vote you must blacken the oval (○) completely. An oval blackened (●) to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.</p> <p>2. To vote a straight party ticket, blacken the oval to the left of the name of the party of your choice. To vote for an individual candidate of another party after voting a straight party ticket, blacken the oval to the left of his or her name.</p> <p>3. For an office where you may vote for more than ONE candidate, you may divide your vote among the candidates. For such offices votes shall not be counted for candidates not individually marked.</p> <p>4. To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, blacken the oval to the left of the line provided, and write the name of the candidate on the line provided for that purpose.</p> <p>5. If you make a mistake, do not erase. Ask for a new ballot.</p> <p>6. Use only the marker provided.</p> <p>7. DO NOT fold the ballot.</p> <p>8. DO NOT tear off the stub. Place this ballot in the secrecy sleeve with only the number stub showing before leaving the booth and then show the stub to an election officer. When instructed by the election officer to do so, remove the stub containing the number and immediately slide the ballot from the secrecy sleeve into the ballot box. INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER:

- 1. To vote, you must blacken the oval (○) completely.
- 2. An oval blackened (●) to the left of the word "YES" indicates a vote FOR Retention.
- 3. An oval blackened (●) to the left of the word "NO" indicates a vote AGAINST Retention.
- 4. If you make a mistake, do not erase. Ask for a new ballot.
- 5. Use only the marker provided.
- 6. **DO NOT** fold the ballot.
- 7. **DO NOT** tear off the stub. Place this ballot in the secrecy sleeve with only the number stub showing before leaving the booth and then show the stub to an election officer. When instructed by the election officer to do so, remove the stub containing the number and immediately slide the ballot from the secrecy sleeve into the ballot box. Any ballot deposited in a ballot box without having the number stub torn off will not be counted.
