| <p style="text-align: center;">INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER:</p> <p>1. TO VOTE YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL (○) COMPLETELY. An oval blackened (●) to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.</p> <p>2. To vote for a person whose name is NOT on the ballot, YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL to the left of the line provided, and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.</p> <p>3. If you make a mistake, DO NOT ERASE. Ask for a new ballot.</p> <p>4. USE ONLY THE MARKER PROVIDED.</p> <p>5. DO NOT FOLD THE BALLOT unless voting absentee.</p> <p>6. DO NOT tear off the stub. Place this ballot in the secrecy sleeve with only the numbered stub showing before leaving the booth and then show the stub to an election officer. When instructed by the election officer to do so, remove the stub containing the number and then immediately slide the ballot from the secrecy sleeve into the ballot box.
