



FULTON COUNTY DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about March 17, 2020 COVID-19 has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage and suffering to the persons and property of Fulton County; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 has the potential to effect the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Fulton County and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Fulton County may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Fulton County;

NOW THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Commissioners of Fulton County, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 C.S.A., Section 7101 et seq., do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Fulton County.


FURTHER, we direct the Fulton County Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all the appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this disaster emergency.
