



Magisterial District Reestablishment Report

39th Judicial District

Franklin and Fulton Counties

2022 – 2031

Issued: January 28, 2022

Introduction

In June 2021, all President Judges were notified by Geoff Moulton, Court Administrator of Pennsylvania that the decennial reestablishment of Magisterial Districts is once again upon us. Decennial reestablishment of magisterial districts is mandated by 42 Pa.C.S.A. § 1503 (a) Reestablishment of Districts, which requires that the Court reestablish the numbers and boundaries of the magisterial districts the year after the census figures are certified by the Census Bureau.

The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania approved the process for 2021 reestablishment with the guiding principle that each president judge determine if they have the proper number of Magisterial District Judges (MDJs) needed to handle the caseload in their judicial district. The reestablishment plan is a ten-year plan meant to accommodate the needs of the citizens of the county for the next decade. Caseload and workload (weighted caseload) data for each magisterial district was provided by the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts (AOPC) to President Judges and District Court Administrators based on six years of case data, covering 2014 through 2019. Caseload is defined as the total number of cases filed according to the data retrieved from the Magisterial District Judge System as entered in the MDJ Offices. Workload is defined as the amount of work or effort needed by the MDJ for a particular case type. Because of the judicial emergency, the 2020 statistics were excluded as not representative of the typical filings in each district. Comparative data was provided for each class of county to allow comparison to the caseloads and workloads with those of similar size counties.

The statistics provided by AOPC were broken down by municipality for criminal, traffic, non-traffic, and private complaints. Civil, landlord-tenant, and miscellaneous docket statistics were only available by magisterial district. Average filings per magisterial district were provided by case type for each county and class of county statewide. Workload statistics, which were calculated by using the relative case type weights based upon the amount of judge time required to process each case type. Actual case filings are then adjusted by the weights. Weights were derived from a 2011-2012 caseload study conducted by the Weighted Caseload Committee which was comprised mainly of MDJs with support from the AOPC and Court Administration. This measure reflects the relative amount of work required by the judge to handle the mix of case types in their respective district.

Guidelines

Each judicial district was tasked to answer two questions in determining how to realign the magisterial district courts in their judicial district. *First*, how many magisterial districts do you need to handle the case filings, not just now, but for the next ten years? *Second*, where should the boundaries of those districts be drawn so that the workload is equitably distributed among the MDJs in the county? There are no presumptions that there are too many or too few districts. That is for each president judge to recommend. If a magisterial district falls at the lower end of the caseload range, the president judge must evaluate this factor in formulating their realignment proposal. The workload calculation differentiates between treating all case types the same and acknowledging that a different level of effort is required for different types of cases.

In addition to assessing caseload and workload, there are factors that should be considered. For example: all portions of the magisterial district must be contiguous; no district can be eliminated during the term of an incumbent MDJ; District boundaries cannot be redrawn in such a way that would move an incumbent magisterial district judge's residence into another magisterial district; and voting districts cannot be split. The process should involve discussion with the MDJs in your judicial district, which was through a judicial liaison/Court Administration process.

The communication received from AOPC in June that was issued to all president judges was shared with the MDJs in the 39th Judicial District. This liaison practice is in addition to quarterly scheduled meetings. An MDJ liaison for both counties is identified and agreed upon by all MDJ's. The liaison becomes the point of contact for discussion on matters, collaborates with their MDJ colleagues, and offers input on behalf of the other MDJ's for discussion with the President Judge and Court Administration. This process is efficient and effective. The MDJ liaisons were included in this process.

As for the proposed plan itself, the President Judge for each District is required to make a final recommendation to the Pennsylvania Supreme Court. The proposed reestablishment plan must be posted for public comment before submission to AOPC. Interested parties have thirty days from the publishing date to submit written comments to Court Administration.

The following report, along with required worksheets provided by the AOPC is what the AOPC requires to be published for public review.

Note:

1. Magisterial District Summary Worksheets for each MDJ office were completed and are attached below.
2. Magisterial District Summary Worksheets for each office were completed first using the current data and again using data respective of the proposed changes as a result of the recommendations.
3. The second version of the Magisterial District Summary Worksheets captures the proposed changes as a result of realignment and elimination. These worksheets were re-calculated in consultation and with the assistance of an AOPC Judicial Programs Administrator responsible for Reestablishment. Adjusted caseload and workload averages for six not seven District Courts were then utilized.

Recommendation:

Because the 39th Judicial District spans two counties, magisterial districts within each county were separately considered. Final proposed outcomes include:

Reestablishment - no changes are made to boundaries for the district court.

Realignment - existing boundaries are changed (townships, cities, boroughs, wards are added or removed).

Eliminate - the townships, cities, boroughs, or wards are distributed equitably among one or more of the remaining magisterial districts.

39th Judicial District – Fulton County Branch

There is no recommendation to eliminate any existing district courts within Fulton County. The following is recommended:

- District Court 39-4-01: Reestablish
- District Court 39-4-02: Realign
- District Court 39-4-03: Realign

Note:

1. Fulton County is the second largest 8th class County in terms of annual average filings per Court out of six total 8th class counties.
2. Fulton County utilizes a Central Court program. This increases the workload for all MDJs that are not captured in any data because all three MDJs rotate through Central Court.
3. All MDJs in Fulton County take rotations with regards to being on call.
4. District Court 39-4-03 has the highest caseload and highest workload of all Districts. With regards to caseload, District Court 39-4-03 is 139% more than that of District Court 39-4-02.
5. As a result of the disparity in caseload and workload, realignment of 39-4-03 and 39-4-02 is appropriate.

39th Judicial District – Franklin County Branch

The recommendation is to reestablish, realign, and eliminate district courts within Franklin County. The following is recommended:

- District Court 39-2-01: Reestablish
- District Court 39-3-02: Reestablish
- District Court 39-3-03: Eliminate
- District Court 39-3-04: Realign
- District Court 39-3-05: Realign
- District Court 39-3-06: Realign
- District Court 39-3-07: Realign

There are several reasons for these recommendations.

1. In 2010, Franklin County moved from 5th class status to 4th class status due to population growth of nearly 16% from 2002. In 2020, Franklin County population grew, but only by 4%. In addition, Franklin County is the second smallest 4th class County of nine total 4th class counties.
2. AOPC guidelines state that all portions of the magisterial district must be contiguous. District Court 39-3-07 has the highest filings followed by District Court 39-2-01. District Court 39-2-01 has the highest workload followed by District Court 39-3-02. District Court 39-3-06 has the lowest caseloads and second lowest workload. District Court 39-3-03 has the second lowest caseloads and the lowest workload. The District Courts on the lower end of the range for caseload and workload are: 39-3-05, 39-3-06 and 39-3-03. This illustrates a variance ranging from 91% to 100% when compared to Districts on the higher end of the range. However, not all these districts are contiguous to those with the highest loads, so a simple shift of caseload and workload is not possible because this would result in a non-contiguous split.
3. Given #2 above, to achieve a better balance of caseload and workload equity, realignment and/or elimination have to be considered.
4. Regarding districts with low caseloads and low workloads, proposed and projected growth of those districts were taken into consideration. Districts 39-3-05 and 39-3-06 are anticipated to continue to have growth consistent with an increased population in 2020. In District 39-3-05, Norfolk Southern Intermodal Project has resumed operations, there are 600 homes approved for Antrim Township, and a new warehouse is currently under construction that with conservative estimates will bring 1,000 jobs. District 39-3-06 neighbors Antrim Township and anticipates contiguous business district growth as a result of increased commercial and residential growth, combined with a poultry farm that is expected to bring a conservative estimate of 600 jobs. In addition, new commercial entities are currently under construction in the Borough of Mercersburg.
5. Realignment of District 39-3-07 will result in a decrease in caseload and workload. However, to increase both caseload and workload, an Administrative Order by the president judge will

direct all non-Interstate traffic citations from Guilford 1, 3, & 4 to be filed in 39-3-07, not 39-3-05. This will create desired equity regarding caseloads and workloads associated with these filings for both Districts 39-3-07 and 39-3-05.

6. Franklin County utilizes a Central Court program with District 39-3-07 designated as the supervising MDJ. This increases the workload for District 39-3-07 that is not captured in any data. In addition, all seven MDJs in Franklin County will still rotate through Central Court which increases workload not captured in the data.
7. All MDJs in Franklin County take rotations with regards to being on call. In Franklin County, the continued practice will be that the on-call judge will docket the case to the respective municipality. This will provide a more accurate reflection of caseloads and workloads for all districts.
8. Careful consideration of future filings has also been taken into consideration by evaluating case filing trends during the past several years, reviewing population trends and demographics and their correlation to caseloads.
